This position will have a passion for working with young children and promoting their well-being through healthy meals and positive meal-time experiences.

Key Responsibilities:

Centre Cook

- Menu development of planning nutritious meals and snacks for full day daycare and before & after school programs, including providing substitute meals for children with special dietary requirements and/or food allergies
- Delivering snack and meal carts to the program rooms
- Washing dishes and equipment as required, in accordance with Ministry and Public Health guidelines
- Responsible for the safety in the kitchen environment/Maintain clean and sanitary kitchen and storage facilities
- Ensures safe food storage and disposal and complies with all health and hygiene requirements under all food safety legislation
- Ensure daily, weekly, and monthly inspections, deep cleaning, and maintenance are performed.
- Communicating with daycare program staff regarding any daily menu changes, or feedback on menu items
- Grocery shopping and preparing shopping list for all necessary kitchen and food items, as well as maintaining kitchen inventory
- Completing weekly and monthly budget tracking/receipt reporting
